Glass Restore & Repel Kit

Instructions for Use (English)

The best place to apply the Nu Finish® Scratch Doctor™ Restore & Repel Kit is inside a controlled environment such as a garage, protecting your vehicle from environmental conditions that may disrupt appropriate application.



STEP 1 POLISHING COMPOUND GLASS PREP

YOU WILL NEED:
Nu Finish® Polishing Compound
Precision Applicator
1 Clean Applicator Sponge
Clean Microfiber Cloths
Garden Hose & Water



STEP 2 SEALANT SEALING THE GLASS

YOU WILL NEED:
Nu Finish® Sealant
Precision Applicator
1 Clean Applicator Sponge
Clean Microfiber Cloths

1

Lift windshield wipers and remove large debris such as leaves.



2

Shake bottle well before use and remove seal.



3

Apply the polishing compound to the Precision Applicator sponge, or with Applicator in hand apply compound directly to glass (windshield). Begin polishing in circular motions to remove stuck on contaminants and debris. Be sure to polish the whole surface with extra focus on any problem areas, scratches and stuck on debris.

Rinse the glass thoroughly with water to remove all polish and contaminants.

Dry the glass completely using a clean, dry microfiber towel prior to applying the Step 2 Sealant.

Remove the sponge from the applicator by gently squeezing the edges to release the sponge. Replace with the clean second sponge before commencing Step 2 - Sealant, black side down.



NOTE: If any dirt or debris remains on the glass surface, simply wash the sponge and re-polish the surface following steps 1-6 above or clean with an Auto Glass Cleaner that does not leave behind a coating.

To open* cap, push down and turn. Apply the Sealant sparingly to the fully dry glass surface starting at the top of the glass.

Using the Precision Applicator with the second clean sponge in place, begin at the top of the glass and spread the Sealant evenly in long, sweeping horizontal motions across the glass. For larger surfaces such as windshields, sun/moon roofs apply to half of the surface at a time.

Repeat Step 3 for the other half of larger glass surfaces. Sealant will not be completely dry.



NOTE: The glass surface may look textured and cloudy as it starts to cure.

Wait 10 minutes, then buff the surface to a smooth clear finish using a clean, dry microfiber towel.

Allow the Sealant to cure fully for 90 minutes. Do NOT use windshield wipers or expose the glass to water during the cure time. If any cloudy spots appear during curing, buff the area with a dry microfiber cloth.

Immediately following treatment, thoroughly wash both sponges with water and allow them to air dry for future use.



Pro Tip: Apply second coating of the Sealant and allow another 90 minutes for curing for increased repellency.

*After opening, use Sealant within 15 days.
